Topics be discussed

- 1) We have many urologists who have their own nursing home, some are attached to corporate hospital, some have roaming practice – what is the financial stability in corporate hospitals, are urologists exploited by corporate hospitals? If yes, how to overcome such situation?
- 2) What is the financial viability of small individual nursing home in present era?
- 3) How to decide charge of particular surgery – be it corporate, or individual hospital. How do we calculate our own value for doing particular surgery?
- 4) Financial implications of newer high cost machines – Robot, High watt laser...etc
- 5) How much urologists should invest in buying personal equipments till what age? What is the limit.
- 6) Operative charges under CGHS, or state sponsored schemes (yojana) are getting reduced day by day – how to overcome those problems? Can we collectively do something?
- 7) Insurance companies, TPA - dictate to urologists – how to overcome that.
- 8) Problems of cashless insurance services – lessons learnt.
- 9) Insurance of instruments – Is it a myth or reality?
- 10) What could be optimal minimum salary / remuneration of urologist – who has just passed DNB/MCh, what could they expect after 3 yrs, 5 yrs post qualification? in different cities, Metros, Tier 1 or tier 2 cities.
- 11) How to overcome financial insecurity which comes as age advances, or sometimes urologists are forced to change job,
- 12) Where to invest – stock market or MF?
- 13) Which are best investment options?
- 14) Myths & reality of life insurance -
- 15) Which are various tax saving methods? – investments, HUF, Loans, educations...etc
- 16) You will agree that all of us are like daily wage workers. Unless we ourselves are not on site, we shall not earn money. That is limitation of our profession. It is possible that we meet with accident, unexpected debility, ...etc in this background, how to plan for the future, how to continue to earn decent money even after retirement.
- 17) Financial burden out of litigations – how to take personal protection schemes, which things to look for, what are loop holes?
- 18) Group insurance for urologists – welfare scheme – by USI – is it possible & are we ready for that?
- 19) Wealth creation by Urologists. –we work hard, we attend calls, we struggle & sweat if there are complications, but in most situation, on our hard work, someone else earns money & they create wealth. Why can't we create wealth for ourselves? Is it possible? What are the ways & means?
